MEMBERSHIP BRIEF

THE INTERNATIONAL ACADEMY OF TELEVISION ARTS & SCIENCES is a membership based organization comprised of leading media and entertainment figures from all sectors of television including internet, mobile and technology.

Headquartered in New York City, the Academy is a truly international body with members from over 50 countries and 500 companies.

The Academy is dedicated to fostering relationships among international broadcasters as well as encouraging the highest quality in worldwide television programming. The Academy recognizes excellence through its prestigious International Emmy® Award, presented every November at the Annual International Emmy® Awards Gala in New York City. In addition to the Gala, the Academy's yearly schedule of events includes The International Digital Emmy® Awards at MIPTV and a series of industry events such as Academy Day, The International Emmy® World Television Festival and Panels on substantive industry topics.

Members are encouraged to actively participate through regular attendance at Board Meetings, Panels, Cocktails and other events. The mandatory annual membership fee is \$1,000 USD.

As the organization is supported largely by contributions from its members, the purchase of tables/tickets to the Gala and the placing of an ad, in our publication called the Almanac, are encouraged and appreciated.

The design and execution of the Academy's programs are committee-driven. Members express their views and can become involved in committees reflecting their interests and experience. The Executive Committee steers the organization and conducts ongoing business between Board Meetings. Decisions made at these meetings are implemented by the Executive Director and his or her staff.

Prospective Members must be nominated by an existing member of the organization. They are elected by a majority vote of the Board of Directors. To be eligible, prospective members must be employed in a position of high responsibility for a minimum of two years in a company or organization that is either directly engaged in, or providing services to, the television industry including internet, mobile and technology. The initial term is one year and will automatically be renewed annually upon the anniversary of election. Resignations will only be accepted in writing to the office of the Academy, and must be submitted prior to or during the month of the election anniversary. Since membership is personal, members are responsible for informing the Academy of any changes in job status or contact details. The Nominating Committee reserves the right to review a membership should the member's job status change during the term.

Each member brings specific expertise and professional involvement to the organization. Members have the opportunity to attend meetings, chair committees and speak on issues before the Board. The right to vote at the Board Meeting on specific issues concerning the Academy is, however, reserved to its Directors.

The International Academy of Television Arts & Sciences meets three to four times per year, with the November Board Meeting coinciding with the Gala in New York. In addition to dealing with administrative business, Members are encouraged to participate in panel discussions covering current industry trends and relevant business issues. Members bring vast knowledge of the international media and share expertise with their peers.

Supporting an international organization with a truly global structure where members meet, interact and have the chance to exchange ideas is a rare opportunity. There is no other organization of global broadcasters like The International Academy of Television Arts & Sciences.
