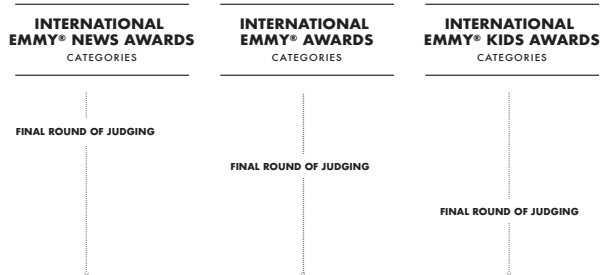
## SEMI-FINAL ROUND OF JUDGING
